



Do you want to be a Theatre Bristol Agent?

I'm happy to report that I've since secured the interest of a producer for our 'Playscapes' project, due in part to the inspiration and evidence that I gained at the conference. At Theatre Bristol we want to shine a light on independent artists and producers who help lead and shape the future of the arts.

We know it can be hard for independents to attend conferences and events, and that industry gatherings are often only accessible to salaried staff. That's why we offer help with tickets, travel or accommodation costs for 'TB Agents' - artists and producers who want to attend events to soak up new ideas, make contacts and represent the independent sector.

All we ask in return is that they find a way to share their experience and learning. This might be by live tweeting the event, writing a blog, making a podcast, or hosting a conversation.

This is an extra opportunity to apply for our TB Agents bursary, specifically to attend the next [IETM meeting in Hull on 28-31 March 2019](#). This meeting will explore the reality of inclusion in today's societies, in their artistic representations and in the process of creation.

We are able to fully fund one person to attend this meeting, including ticket, accommodation, travel and subsistence costs, to be negotiated and agreed with Theatre Bristol.

Application deadline: **Monday 21st January 2019**.

What happens?

The process is very straightforward. Just send us a proposal (1 side of A4 max.) to info@theatrebristol.net answering the following questions:

1. Please tell us a bit about your practice.
2. Why do you want to attend this event?
3. How will you share the learning, contacts, and ideas with other people in Bristol?
4. How much money do you need and what is it for?

Application deadline: Monday 21st January 2019.

We will let you know the panel's decision in early February.

If you're successful we'll spread the word via theatrebristol.net and our newsletter that you are going to the event as a TB Agent in case anyone wants to find out more.

All we ask is that you write about your experience for theatrebristol.net or come up with another way to share your learning. We'll also send you a very short feedback form.
